Communication

Your teacher will confirm with you his/her preferred method of communication. We ask that people respect school hours when communicating with teachers. If a parent wishes to speak to a teacher please arrange via the office on the relevant campus.

Meals

We are delighted to have been successful in our application for the school meals scheme. In line with regulations, a contract of this nature and size must be advertised and filled through the e-tenders process. When a successful contractor has been appointed we will advise you further.

In the meantime children bring their lunches as normal and as always we encourage healthy eating with fizzy drinks and chewing gum strictly prohibited.

Traffic Flow

Careful consideration was given last year to the health and safety of our campuses in terms of traffic flow. We remind people that Park & Stride from our local town car parks is strongly encouraged. Please apply for your parking permit using the leaflet attached to this email.

Staff car parks are for staff only.

Cars are **not to remain in set down areas**. They are for drop and go only.

Staff are on supervision duty for 10 minutes before entry time on each campus. There is no need to wait with your child. Independence should be encouraged from the start.

Uniform

Pupils must wear the correct uniform. Your teacher will advise you regarding 'tracksuit days' for children from 1st to 6th class. Excessive jewellery and hair dye are prohibited.

Attendance

Regular school attendance is crucial for student success. We monitor attendance closely. We kindly ask parents to use the school 'Aladdin' app to communicate any reasons for their child's absences. We are obliged to report any absences in excess of 20 days in any school year.

On enrolment every parent / guardian acknowledged acceptance of our school's code of behaviour. Respectful behaviour is expected by all members of our school community at all times.

Mobile Phones & Smartwatches
